Foreigners who spend less than 90 days in the country will be required to use their passports for financial transactions. For any enquiries;

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You may continue to make deposits (cash, cheques, and transfers) into an account which has not been previously updated with the Ghana Card, provided you provide your Ghana Card as identification at the point of making the deposit. For any enquiries;

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Please endeavour to update your personal information including your Ghana Card details at your bank or other licensed financial institution as soon as possible. This will allow for easy identification at the point of any transaction you might want to engage in and facilitate completion of your transaction. For any enquiries;

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Beware! You cannot effect withdrawals or make transfers if your account has not been linked with the Ghana Card. For any enquiries;

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Non-resident Ghanaians who do not have the Ghana Card may use their Passports issued by any jurisdiction to access financial transactions at all Bank of Ghana licensed institutions. For any enquiries;

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Are you a member of the Diplomatic Corps? You may use your foreign passport as a means of identification for all banking transactions.

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Don't be a victim! Secure your personal banking information and protect your money. Your bank or other financial institution is not likely to call you or send you an email or text message requesting your password, personal identification number (PIN), account number, one-time password (OTP) or other banking details for the purpose of verifying or updating your account records. Please report any such message you receive to your customer service representative at your bank or other financial institution or contact the Bank of Ghana.

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
