Rationale/ Expected Contribution	The purpose of the position of Legal Counsel is to provide reliable, timely and well-informed advice to the Agency on legal matters and on the potential legal implications of policy proposals, practices and projects related to the Agency's work to establish a single currency for ECOWAS Member States.

Job description	 To conduct legal analysis and research on legal issues confronting the Agency and provide advice and support to Senior Management and staff in mitigating legal related risks. Liaise with key stakeholders on legal matters including harmonization of legal frameworks by Member Central Banks and Member States. Manage litigation by and against the Agency, including liaison with external attorneys engaged to handle matters on behalf of the Agency. Negotiate, draft and review contracts. Assist in ensuring compliance with all laws, regulations, policies, codes and standards.
Qualification	 Applicants must be nationals of ECOWAS Member States and should have the following background, experience and competencies: Holder of a Bachelor's Degree in Law from a recognized University. Must have at least three years (3) post bar call-up experience. Applicants must be fluent in one of the official languages of the Community (ECOWAS): English, French and Portuguese. A working knowledge of another will be an added advantage.
