### **BANK OF GHANA GOVERNOR TAKES TERMINAL LEAVE**

**31 January 2025, Accra:** The public is hereby informed that from **February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025**, the Governor of the Bank of Ghana, Dr Ernest Addison, will start his terminal leave ahead of his retirement from the Bank. Dr Addison was appointed on April 3, 2017, and reappointed for a second term on March 29, 2021.

In line with the Bank of Ghana Act, 2002 (Act 612), *as amended*, his tenure as Governor of the Bank of Ghana will end on March 28, 2025, after he successfully served two full terms.

Accordingly, Dr Ernest Addison has decided to take his accumulated leave, effective **February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025**, ahead of his retirement from the Bank on **March 28, 2025**. This has received the approval of H.E. President John Mahama.

The Bank of Ghana thanks the Governor for his meritorious and distinguished service to the Bank and the Republic and wishes Dr Ernest Addison a restful retirement. -END-
