The Bank of Ghana is pleased to announce that on Tuesday 25th February 2025 the President of the Republic of Ghana, H.E. John Dramani Mahama, swore into Office Dr. Johnson Pandit Asiamah and Dr. Zakari Mumuni as the Governor and First Deputy Governor Bank of Ghana, respectively of the Bank of Ghana. The appointment and subsequent swearing in of Dr. Asiamah and Dr. Mumuni are in accordance with 183(4)(a) of the 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana and section 8 of Bank of Ghana Act, 2002 (Act 612) as amended.

Dr. Asiamah holds a Ph.D in Economics from University of Southampton, UK and has over 23 years of practice and experience in macroeconomics, monetary policy formulation and central banking. He previously served in various roles in the Bank, culminating in his appointment as a Deputy Governor in April 2016.

Dr. Zakari Mumuni is a Ph.D holder in Economics from the University of Nottingham with over 20 years' experience in economic forecasting, modelling, and central banking. He was until his appointment, the Director and Head of Financial Markets Department of the Bank.

Dr. Johnson Pandit Asiamah and Dr. Zakari Mumuni assume responsibility as the new Management of the Bank, following the retirement of the previous Management led by Dr. Ernest Addison.
