GHANA RETAINS TOP SPOT IN GSMA'S 2025 MOBILE MONEY REGULATORY INDEX

Ghana has maintained its position as the world's leading country in mobile money regulation, according to the Global System for Mobile Communications Association (GSMA) Mobile Money Regulatory Index (MMRI) 2025. Ghana achieved an overall score of 96.10 per cent, from 95.06 per cent in the previous year.

This milestone underscores Ghana's leadership in creating a world-class regulatory environment that enables mobile money services to thrive, drive financial inclusion and foster innovation in the digital financial ecosystem.
